- <u>HB 2348</u> Zach Gearhart Weekend was spent reviewing the bill. Shared the history of Emporia State University and their dissolution of tenure (which is currently being litigated). Notable points shared:s\$2mil) to litigate if the bill passes
 - o Likely will lead to problems with attracting faculty
 - President Muma does not support
 - Working with KBOR to strategize
 - House judiciary committee meeting on 2/11/25
 - Expedited timeline (out of house and to senate)
 - First hearing and first committee (many more steps)
 - Talking with governor and legislators

- FOTY Award Revision For non-tenure track (NTT) revised language to the <u>criteria</u> related to adding NTT and adjusting timeline and revised language to the <u>award</u> <u>description</u>. Please send any input to President Muether, who will take to KBOR if needed.
 - Clarification that the 15-page limit does not include CV.
- Billingham Concerns regarding the inclement weather language from university being confusing. Faculty maintain prerogative as to how to deliver their courses. Faculty are encouraged to please communicate with students. Second comment: emergency meeting regarding current legislation, no provision for emergency meetings in rules. Should consider adding.
- Rai Concerns with the accommodations policy, such as delays with assignments and implementing the accommodations. Recommends consider a policy change.
 - President Muether referred any accommodations questions to the office of <u>Student</u> <u>Accommodations and Testing</u>.
