



Museum Studies Certificate Program

The Wichita State University Museum Studies Certificate Program is designed for graduate students and for those who currently work in museums. This is an interdisciplinary program that prepares students for careers in the museum field and will enhance the education and knowledge of those currently working in museums. Drawing on courses from the School of Art and Design and Creative Industries, Anthropology, Public Administration and History, students gain an overview of museum practice including administration, collections, exhibitions, preservation, education and public engagement. This program teaches not only the theory behind museum practices but also gives students an opportunity to receive on-the-job experience.

The program consists of 15 credit hours. To complete with the certificate program, students will take the following management based courses:

- History 703 Museum Administration... 3
- Public Administration 870 Fundraising and Management... 3.

Plus 3 hours of practice that include any of the following:
