CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

▼ **CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT** is a process that allows students to take college courses while still in high school. This process is designed to help students save time and money by completing college credits before entering college. However, it is important to understand that concurrent enrollment does not guarantee that the credits will transfer to another institution. The transferability of credits depends on the policies of the receiving institution and the accreditation of the college where the course was taken. Students should consult with their high school counselor and the admissions office of the college they plan to attend to ensure that their concurrent enrollment credits will transfer.
