The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide learning objectives regarding the Allen Community College transfer process for students pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice at Wichita State University. This document is intended to provide information for all to access and use.

Students should refer to transfer sheets for the minimum number of courses at least 60 hours of college credit from Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed or earned A/A- in Criminal Justice. This depicts a sample of courses that may be completed.
