



2 + 2 Articulation Agreement

Wichita State University Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with a minor in Workforce Leadership and Applied Studies and Butler Community College Sport Management Association (A.S.)

The purpose of this 2 + 2 articulation agreement is to provide Butler Community College students the opportunity to transfer coursework from Butler Community College to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management with a minor in Workforce Leadership and Applied Studies.

In addition, this articulation agreement outlines requirements, options, equivalencies, and parameters, which will benefit many students for years to come. This document is intended as a program of study with a list of equivalent Butler CC and WSU courses by term for the first two years at Butler CC; and a list of WSU courses to complete upon transfer to the four-year institution.

Admission/Program/Graduation Information

General Education Coursework: The completion and transfer of general education coursework will vary based on the program. General education courses must be at least three (3) credit hours and must be approved on the approved general education course list at Wichita State University. Courses transferring from Butler CC to WSU must be on the approved general education program at WSU at the time of transfer. Graduation Requirements: Transfer students must complete 60 hours of college work and 45 hours of upper division work at WSU. For more information, visit www.wichita.edu.

For graduation, students will need to meet all enrollment eligibility requirements at the time of transfer and/or enrollment, fulfill all WSU general education requirements and degree requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as determined by WSU.

Admission to WSU: To apply for admission, students may contact WSU by calling (316) 978-2085 or WSU Office of Adult Learning by calling (316) 978-8325. Information and applications are located online, <https://www.wichita.edu/admissions/index.php>.

Students transferring to WSO need to meet the requirements for admission to the program. All students will have their previous evaluation on an individual basis.

Scholarship/Financial Aid Financial Aid will be applied to students who are admitted and granted by contacting the Financial Aid Office (316) 978-3430 or Butler's Financial Aid Office 322-3121. Student may also visit the Office of Financial Aid on campus for more information.

The agreement for WSO students:

- Completed or began an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree in Sport Management
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSO

BCC WSO students meeting the agreement:

- Be admitted to WSO WSI for the Bachelor of Arts in Sport Management
- Be awarded a scholarship as a requirement and receipt
- Be required to meet the General Education Policy of WSO
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 60 credit hours
