



### 2+2 Articulation

Wichita State University and Butler

March 27, 2010

The purpose of this 2+2 articulation agreement between Butler Community College and Wichita State University (WSU) is to provide an opportunity for students to earn an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree at Butler Community College and transfer to WSU in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree.

This agreement

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree at Butler Community College
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Butler students completing the following

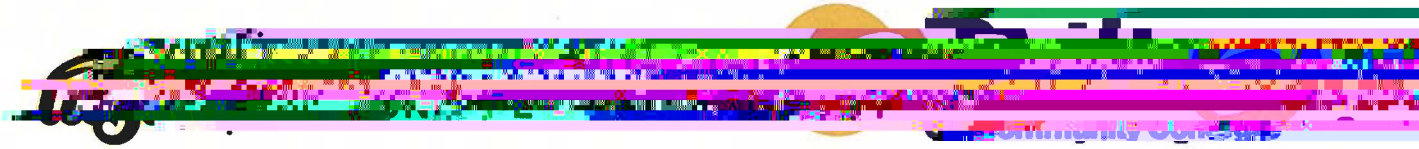
- Be guaranteed admission to WSU with junior status upon receipt of an offer of admission and receipt of a transcript
- Enter with junior status toward a baccalaureate degree
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits (not more than 64 credits) earned up to but not exceeding 64 credits from Butler with an earned grade of a C or better

Students completing academic and navigation scholarship requirements will be eligible for a WSU scholarship. For more information, contact the Office of Student Services at WSU.

For graduation, students will need to fulfill transfer coursework from Butler along with all WSU general education requirements, degree requirements, and graduation as outlined by WSU.

Students transferring to WSU from Butler who have completed an A.A. degree at Butler will meet the minimum requirements for admission to WSU and will have their transcripts evaluated on an individual basis.
