



2+2 Articulation Agreement
Wichita State University and Butler Community College

March 27, 2019

The purpose of this 2+2 agreement is to provide Butler Community College students the opportunity to earn a Bachelor's degree from Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Psychology.

This agreement is for Butler students who have:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Sciences (A.S.) degree
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Butler students meeting the above requirements:

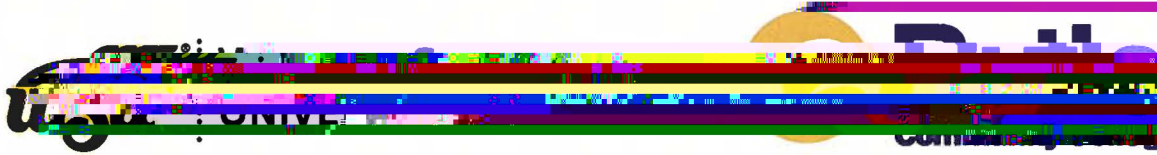
- Be guaranteed admission to WSU
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits (100 level and below) up to a maximum of 64 credits exceeding 64 credits from Butler to WSU

For graduation from WSU with a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree, students will need to fulfill all graduation requirements at WSU, including degree requirements, and must meet the requirements outlined by WSU.
