This agreement is for Butler County students who have:

- Earned an Associates of Arts (A.A.) or Associates of Science (A.S.) degree from Butler County Community College
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Butler students who meet the following requirements will:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits earned at Butler County Community College to WSU
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits earned at Butler County Community College to WSU
