

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN**

WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND HUTCHINSON COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement regards to the Hutchison Community College students pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice degree from the Fairleigh Dickinson University Undergraduate Catalog for all transfer students.

Students must complete at least 60 hours of full-year college work and 45 hours of support work in violation of the transfer credit policy from Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed by a Hutchinson Community College student transferring into WSU to earn the AA or AS in Criminal Justice. This benefits include:
